Well, August is behind us although, here in Florida, that doesn't necessarily mean that the heat is gone. We had some glad things in August and some sad things which are chronicled elsewhere in this publication.

Since it may be cooler now, it may be time to do some wrenching (spannering?) on our chariots since the "cooler" weather will permit more frequent use. Of course, it helps to have appropriate replacement parts on hand before starting and there are as many purveyors of such goodies as ever. We are no longer dependent on the knacker's yards for used parts of questionable utility and quality as, unless you need a bonnet badge for your Humber Super Snipe, even major parts are readily available.

The next concern should be tools. Everyone is aware that some of our older steeds have some noxious parts named Whitworth. For the most part, these fasteners disappeared in the mid-fifties, and the need for special tools with them. There are only two kinds of tools required in order for you to pursue the maintenance or repair of your Voiture: those you NEED and those you HAVE! Ideally, the two lists are identical. More common bits, like sockets, can be acquired individually at hardware stores or by sorting through the well-organized (HAH) displays at your local flea market where some of the larger sizes can be found. Avoid like the plague the 40-piece in-a-box socket and ratchet sets for ten bucks, as most amount to a single use before the sockets crack or the ratchet strips causing you to deposit fleshy bits on your vehicle. Is Nu-Skin a tool? The same goes for adjustable spanners which are little more than devices for removing the flat sides from nuts and bolt heads, rendering them round and in need of yet another specialized tool.

If purchasing is not an option, then, ignoring the olde adage of "Neither a borrower nor a lender be" find another club member or neighbor who happens to possess the elusive implement and request its temporary use. Key word: temporary, unlike Dagwood Bumstead's use of neighbor Herb Woodley's lawnmower which, if I recall correctly, never went home. A year or so ago, I had need of a 1-7/16" socket for my Herald project. After a highly fruitless search, I borrowed said tool from another club member (I still have it and am not yet done with it). To be fair, several years ago I happened upon a rather complete tube flaring tool and purchased it in case I ever had the need to flare a brake or fuel

line. I have used it once successfully. It is now on loan to the owner of the aforementioned socket. Apparently neither one of us had had a need for the tool on loan to the other so it does not amount to a tool "hostage" situation, and no work is at a standstill for lack of that tool. Yet.

Supposedly the tool kit provided with your vehicle from the works, contains everything the average owner needs to do roadside repair, if you are fortunate to have one. Recommendation is to determine what was originally included, source them, and toss it in the boot (along with the spare drive belt, dynamo, water pump, cylinder head, differential, OK, may be over the top on those last two; however, I once carted around an entire spare engine in the back of a 61 Falcon station wagon for a year until it got installed at the other end of the car). Electrical tape and baling (safety) wire are also helpful.

I'll close with a comment from my favorite professional mechanic: Real men don't eat quiche, real women don't pump gas, and mechanics DON'T LEND TOOLS!

**2020 to 2021 RESTORATION**

**In 2020 I restored the interior, sound-deadening material under the carpets, originally white the car was stripped and painted with 4 coats of diamond white (\$3.5K), new body trim work, new dashboard, new seals, new tires, restored rims, new brakes, new top. Complete undercoating. It has the Tonneau cover and top Boot.**

**The motor was removed, bored 20 over and completely rebuilt top to bottom by J&J Racing Engines in Jupiter Florida February 2021. New alternator, battery, cooling fans, gas tank, fuel pump. The smog pump was deleted. The engine installation and Zenith Stromberg carburetor was completely rebuilt by Eagle Automotive Vero Beach Florida.**
