



The following is a personal story submitted by Norm Powers. Norm and his wife Donna joined our club on October 26, 2020, after meeting some of our club members at the October 24, 2020 – Veteran Cemetery Restorations, Inc Benefit and Car Show.

An ongoing love/hate relationship with my Madge.

It all started when I asked a friend to find me an LBC to restore. He found a 1951 MG TD at an estate auction and convinced me it was a great buy. This was in the Berkshires of Western Massachusetts, so after buying the car I rented a car trailer and made a quick trip to Florida hauling the TD and waving to all the people that waved at me on the highway.

But let give you a little history about me. I was into Austin Healy Sprites in the '60s and '70s owning several including one a couple of times. My wife and I enjoyed the sports car scene and did a lot of auto crossing and rallying to the point that she got mad at me once because I wouldn't let her run an auto cross. She was so pregnant with our oldest I couldn't get the seat belt around her.

But then came life; college, kids, work, houses, etc. and the Sprites were gone. Now retired, I wanted to find a B or Spitfire and tinker but along came Madge.

Although she was about 70 years old, she was in fairly good shape having spent many years in a garage. The body paint was dull, but solid. The wood body tub frame I could see was solid as well, so I put her on jack stands and started taking her apart.

It seemed that everything I took off, had at least two things behind it that needed to be replaced. For example, I took off a rear wheel and things were wet. OK a leaking brake cylinder, no big deal, I was going to replace all the brakes anyway. But no, it was the rear axle seal, so I figured seals aren't too bad, but upon examining the parts, found the axle spines were worn (and worn axles on the T's break) so axles were ordered too.

I have spent two years redoing all of Madge's underpinnings, rewiring the dash, trying to stop leaks (hopeless!) adding turn signals (Brits didn't believe in blinkers in the 50s). I have also learned that you B owners don't realize what it's like to work on a car that was designed around whatever parts were available after WWII. The T's were built with any kind and size of nut or bolt available including, but not limited to metric, British Standard Fine, SAE, etc. and they mixed them up so you might find two or more types in the same pattern holding a couple of parts together. At first I thought it was because of 70 years of tinkering, but after studying the issue, I find that there are obscure references to all the fastening bits that have been written about over the years and that was the way they were built.

Well, I have finally gotten Madge healthy enough to take on the road so you may see us out there, and if we are moving, wave. If not moving, please stop and help.



1977 MGB Mark IV Roadster \$12,000

Description -

PLEASE READ THE DETAILS, THIS IS A TOTALLY RESTORED CAR

HISTORY

This is a 1977 MGB Mark IV Roadster. It was purchased from the original owner from Maitland Florida (I have a copy of the original Florida Title from 1977) with 75,120 original miles and has been a Florida car all its life. About 1/3 of those miles were when the car was towed behind a motor home. The car was stored in a garage for many years after the owner passed. During the years of storage there was no maintenance done but the car remained rust free. In 2020, when the family attempted to start and run the car, they did not pay attention to the old fluids (oil and water) and as a result spun the main bearings.

2020 to 2021 RESTORATION

In 2020 I restored the interior, sound-deadening material under the carpets, originally white the car was stripped and painted with 4 coats of diamond white (\$3.5K), new body trim work, new dashboard, new seals, new tires, restored rims, new brakes, new top. Complete undercoating. It has the Tonneau cover

and top Boot.

The motor was removed, bored 20 over and completely rebuilt top to bottom by J&J Racing Engines in Jupiter Florida February 2021. New alternator, battery, cooling fans, gas tank, fuel pump. The smog pump was deleted. The engine installation and Zenith Stromberg carburetor was completely rebuilt by Eagle Automotive Vero Beach Florida.

The car is still in break-in mode with less than 300 miles since rebuild. AS NICE AS IT GETS. Asking \$12K. Eric Michaels 772 713-7885 Micco FL.
